

Harbor View PFO / Brad Evans Memorial Scholarship



Harbor View Elementary school (HVE) prides itself on preparing children to lead successful lives in their families, communities, and careers. If you attended and completed your elementary school education at HVE and will graduate this year from CDM High School, you are eligible to apply for this award. Winners get \$1,000!

Brad Evans attended HVE (where he was ASB President) and CDM High, and was known for his leadership, inclusive nature, great sense of humor, spirit of adventure, and kindness. Brad's memory lives on in recognizing other students of similar character who give back to our community. HVE renamed its scholarship after Brad Evans to honor his legacy of integrity, loyalty, and charity.

This is a character-based scholarship; all eligible students are encouraged to apply regardless of class rank or grade point average.

Note: There is NO REQUIREMENT to attend UC Berkeley for this scholarship.

To apply: Deliver your Cover Sheet for Application and your essay to Harbor View School by the deadline below. Essays should be 700-1200 words (1-2 pages, single-spaced) responding to the following:

How did your experiences at Harbor View Elementary both influence your success at CDM High School, and prepare you to pursue your future life goals?

The policies & criteria for each award are as follows:

1. Each applicant must have attended Harbor View Elementary for a minimum of one full year and be a Harbor View Elementary School Graduate.
2. Each applicant must be a Corona del Mar High School student who is on track to graduate in 2018.
3. Two scholarships will be awarded for \$1,000.00 each. There is no restriction placed on the use of these awards.
4. Winners will be selected at the sole discretion of the Brad Evans Memorial Scholarship committee.
5. Essays shall be scored based on responsiveness to the prompt, demonstration of character development, and appropriate writing style and proficiency. Only original ideas shall be considered. Any copying or plagiarism is immediate grounds for disqualification.

Do NOT include your name on any pages of the actual essay. You may include a title.
